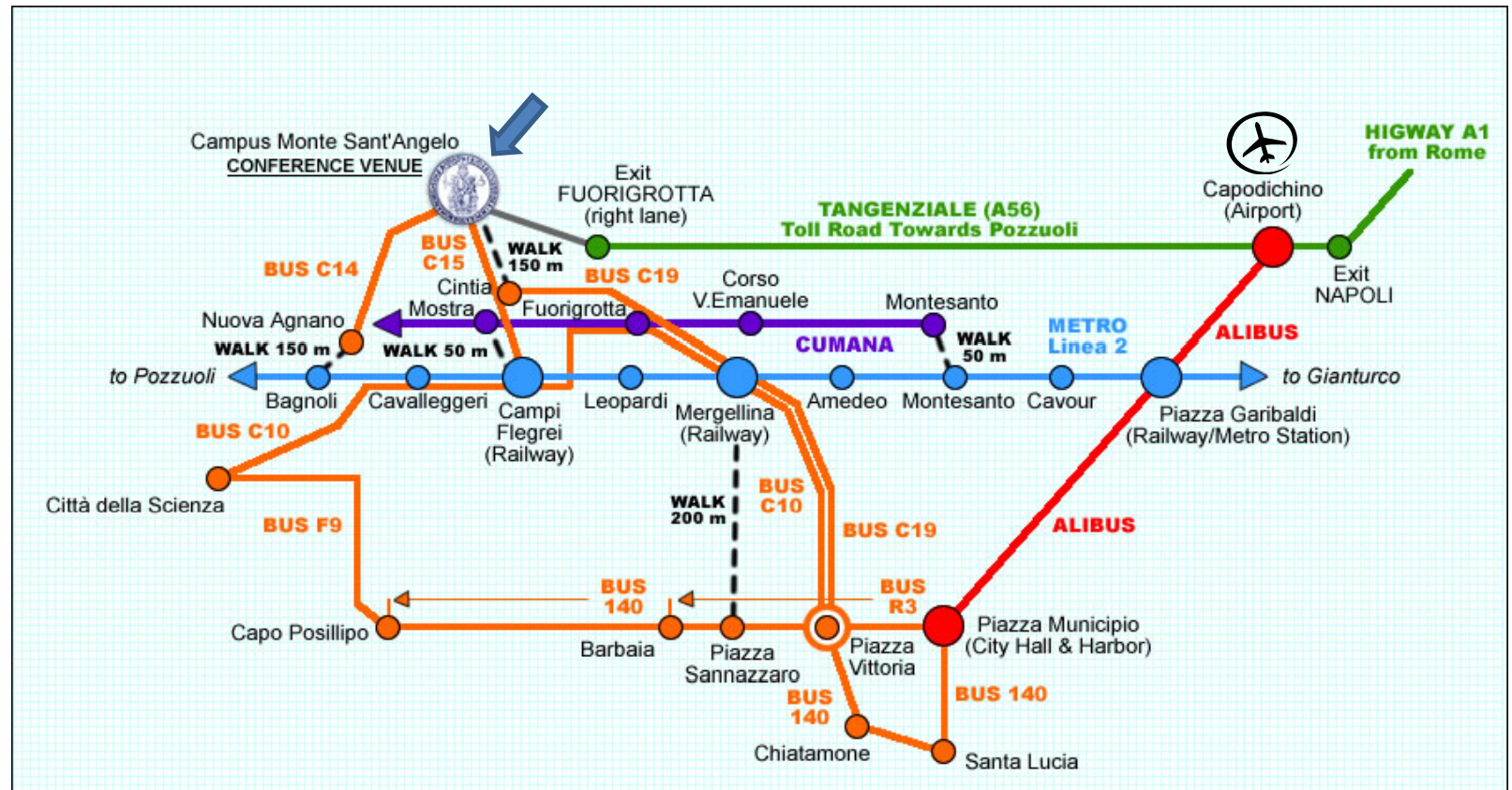


## TRANSPORT INFO

### ALIBUS

This bus connects the *airport* to the *railway/metro station* and to the *city center/harbor*. It departs every 30 min. The ticket *UNICO Alibus* can be purchased on board (fare: € 3.00) and it can be also used on other means (city buses, Metro) after stamping (90 minutes)

### BUS (ANM)

It is the cheapest way for moving around the city, but the schedule is very unreliable because of traffic conditions. Many bus stops are equipped with *INFOSTOP* panels showing waiting time. Buses can get very crowded, in particular the ones leading to University

### METRO Linea 2

This is the oldest Naples Metro line. Tracks are shared with long distance trains, so the schedule is quite reliable depending on time of the day and priority railway service (timetables are posted in each station)

### CUMANA

It is a light railway line very useful for leading University from the old town center. During the morning it is quite frequent and reliable, less in the evening

### TAXI

Taxi rides can be expensive especially in bad traffic conditions. Prices must be listed by law on the back of the front seat: do not accept any higher fare. Beware of abusive taxi drivers soliciting you, take taxis queuing at the marked areas, where a TAXI sign stands

*Typical travel times and fares from city center to Conference venue:*

**TAXI** : 20-30 min (~ € 15.00)

**METRO 2 + BUS C15** : 35-50 min (€ 1.00)

Tickets must be purchased before boarding (*UNICO Napoli fare*: € 1.00) at news stands, tobacco stores or vending machines. After stamping it is possible to travel on the entire city transport system (buses, Metro, etc.) for 90 minutes



**ALWAYS BEWARE OF PICKPOCKETS WHEN BOARDING ON PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION, ESPECIALLY CROWDED BUSES AND METROS**
